

Advanced Search - Category Filter

The **Advanced Search** is a search function in Navigate that lets you create unique cohorts of students based on the layering of various search parameters. The search results are used as the foundation for building [appointment campaigns](#) or tracking student progress. Queries pull lists of currently active students that fit the search parameters. Information in the results reflects *current* student data.

It is important to note that the **Advanced Search** is not meant to be a historical search. The tool can be used to conduct historical searches of currently active students. A student is considered active if they're currently enrolled in courses and if they attended a previous course and did not enroll in the current term.

Service indicators, freshman cohorts, holds, student program cohorts, and minor programs are located in the **Category** filter of the Student Information section of the **Advanced Search**.

Navigator – Advanced Search Categories	
<u>Categories</u>	<u>Description</u>
Academic Probation Hold (MAP MAPR)	MAP MAPR is the service indicator for students who are subject to disqualification.
Applied for UGRD Graduation (UGA UGA)	UGA UGA is used when students have applied to graduate. Hold keeps students from enrolling in other terms after applying to graduate. Application is being reviewed.
<u>ASPIRE (ASPR)</u>	ASPR is used to indicate students who participate in the Asian American and Pacific Islander Retention and Education (ASPIRE) program.
<u>Bad Debt Collection (SFC BDC)</u>	SFC BDC is used when student has university debt that is in collections.
<u>Bad Debt Obligations (SFW BDW)</u>	SFW BDW is used when student has a unpaid delinquent debt with the university.
<u>Bonafide (EOP)</u>	EOP is used to indicate participation in the Educational Opportunity Program (EOP).
<u>California Promise Student (CAPR)</u>	CAPR is used to indicate participation in the California Promise program.
Complied with C19 Policy (CVC CVDP)	Used to indicate if a student has uploaded their COVID-19 vaccination record.
<u>Dean of Students Hold (DOS DOS)</u>	Used to indicate if a student has a conduct related hold on their account.
Enr 1+ on campus course (OCMP)	Used to indicate if a student is enrolled in at least one course on campus.
Fall 2021 Freshman Cohort (20FF)	21FF is used to identify freshman students who started at the university in FA 2021.
Fall 2020 Transfer Cohort (20FT)	21FT is used to identify transfer students who started at the university in FA 2021.
Grad Candidate – Fall 2021 (GC 2217)	GC 2217 is used to identify students who are eligible to apply to graduate in the specified term.
Grad Candidate – Summer 2021 (GC 2215)	GC 2215 is used to identify students who are eligible to apply to graduate in the specified term.
Minor Program (MN)	MN is used to indicate the minor a student is pursuing. MN will appear at the end of the minor program title.
<u>Metro Business #1 (MBUS) & Metro Business #2 (MBU2)</u>	MBUS and MBU2 is used to indicate a student in the specific Metro business academy.

<u>Metro CAD (MY)</u>	MY is used to indicate a student in the specific Metro academy.
<u>Metro Ethnic Studies (MES)</u>	MES is used to indicate a student in the specific Metro academy.
<u>Metro Education (MEDU)</u>	MEDU is used to indicate a student in the specific Metro academy.
<u>Metro Health #1 (MH), Metro Health #2 (MH2), & Metro Health #3 (MH3)</u>	MH, MH2, & MH3 is used to indicate a student in the specific Metro academy.
<u>Metro Liberal & Creative Art 1 (MCLA) & Metro Liberal & Creative Art 2 (MCL2)</u>	MCLA & MCL2 is used to indicate a student in the specific Metro academy.
<u>Metro STEM #1 (MS), Metro STEM #2 (MEGR), Metro STEM #3 (MS3), & Metro STEM #4 (MS4).</u>	MS, MEGR, MS3, & MS4 is used to indicate a student in the specific Metro academy.
<u>MMR Immunization (HEA MMR)</u>	HEA MMR is used to indicate students who have a hold for not submitting proper documentation for immunizations.
<u>OIP Track 1 F1 Students (OIPF)</u>	OIPF is used to identify international students.
<u>Plan-Eligible but no plan (PLN0)</u>	PLN0 is used to indicate students who are eligible for a degree plan but have not created one.
<u>Plan-Current (1-30 days old) (PLN1)</u>	PLN1 is used to indicate students who has a degree plan that is between 1-30 days old.
<u>Plan-Recent (31-90 days old) (PLN2)</u>	PLN2 is used to indicate students who has a degree plan that between 31-90 days old.
<u>Plan-Old (91+ days old) (PLN3)</u>	PLN3 is used to indicate students who has a degree plan that is 90+ days old.
<u>Probation (PROB)</u>	PROB is used to indicate a student who is on probation.
<u>Stu Resource Center Pri Reg (SOAR)</u>	SOAR is used to indicate a student who is participating with the Student Outreach and Academic Retention (SOAR) program.
<u>Subject to Disqualification (SUBJ)</u>	SUBJ is used to indicate a student who is subject to disqualification.
<u>Trio Program (ETRA)</u>	ETRA is used to indicate a student who is participating with the Student Support Services (SSS TRIO) program.
<u>Veteran Priority Registration (VETP)</u>	VETP is used to indicate a student who is a veteran.
<u>Unmet Admission Conditions (UUM UUM)</u>	UUM UUM is used for first semester students who are matriculated but are soon to be no longer matriculated because of unmet admission requirements.
